How 'Learning & Home' works with JCS

With this basic overview of how our 'Learning @ Home' model will operate, you know what to expect and what is expected. Learning @ home isn't easy, so stay in touch with the school about how it's going and how we can help.

Each week . . .

- Parents (and secondary students) will be sent an email with an overview of the coming week.
 - This will show what activities are set and when it is suggested they be completed.
 - This will also show when the teacher has set any video conference calls
- There is flexibility designed into the 'Learning @ Home' schedule, so please use your discretion in supervising the completion of work the best you can
- The Connections Fridge Page will have information for the following week

Each day . . .

- The learning activities for the day will be uploaded to the designated platform
 - o K-2: SeeSaw and email
 - o 3-10: Microsoft Teams
- Teachers will be available for student/parent interaction as required
- Secondary teachers will be online and accessible for their timetabled classes (see special 'Learning @ Home' timetable)
- Student 'attendance/engagement' will be monitored by teachers to help students progress
- The majority of secondary teachers will be available in the flexible learning and communication time in the afternoons.

Every few weeks . . .

- The school will send out a survey to check how things are going
- You don't have to wait for a survey, you can get in touch at any time

Regularly . . .

- Our Teacher Assistants will provide additional support for small groups and individuals, both at school and, where approved, at home.
- Fortnightly resource circulation will occur with deliveries and pick-ups to the home
- Secondary teachers will keep parents and students informed about how students are engaging in the learning programme via the Ongoing Assessment Record (OAR) released in Term 2, 2020.
